 - Average speed 30.4 mph
 - Traffic did not seem significant to deem stop signs
 - Speed bumps discussion
 - Following up for additional help with DOT – supposed to be re-measuring any day now at Erinsbrook / Erinsbrook
 - Cosmetic committee (Mike Wiles) – NEW – need volunteers to help
 - Mike's Mowing – doing great job with common areas
 - Lawns, shrubs, trees out of control (especially around sidewalk)
 - Missing shutters
 - Power wash of siding (excessive mold on house)
 - Outdoor projects left incomplete for weeks
 - Yard of the Month program
- Neighborhood Reminders:
 - Street parking – its hazardous – continued concerns of homeowners also blocking others driveways, etc.
 - Lawns need to be maintained all year long

- Boats should not be parked in the driveways and or on the streets and may not be parked at the pool
- RV parking at the pool by approval of Board only
- Clean up after your pet – pet station at pool and on common areas on Erinsbrook – bags provided by HOA
- Speeding Issues – call the police to report – they will ticket
- For safety walk on Sidewalks and use caution when walking in the street
- Kids at bus stop should respect neighbor’s property – parents should monitor activity of your children
- Kids should be reminded not to cut through other people’s property without their permission
- Be respectful of their neighbor's yards: don't drop trash on them; don't use them as dog walks, and don't steal flowers and fruit from other people's yards
